The undersigned petitioners respectfully represent and state to the Minnesota Water Resources Board:

T.

That this nominating petition is being filed to petition for the establishment of a watershed district to be known as the Prior Lake - Spring Lake Watershed District; that this petition is made pursuant to Chapter 112 of Minnesota Statutes, and as amended, for the establishment of this district.

II.

That the petitioners are resident freeholders of the proposed district, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 112.37, Subdivision 1(4).

III.

That the area to be embraced within the proposed watershed district shall be as set out on the map attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

IV.

That the proposed district is needed to provide an organization to wisely manage and conserve the waters and natural resources within the territory to be included in the district and that said Prior Lake - Spring Lake Watershed District should be established for the following purposes.

- (1) Control or alleviation of damage by flood waters;
- (2) Improvement of stream channels for drainage, navigation, and any other public purpose;
- (3) Reclaiming or filling wet and overflowed lands;
- (4) Providing water supply for irrigation;
- (5) Regulating the flow of streams and conserving the waters thereof;
- (6) Diverting or changing watercourses in whole or in part;
- (7) Providing and conserving water supply for domestic, industrial, recreational or other public use;
- (8) Providing for sanitation and public health and regulating the use of streams, ditches, or watercourses for the purpose of disposing of waste;
- (9) Imposition of preventive or remedial measures for the control or alleviation of land and soil erosion and siltation of watercourses or bodies of water affected thereby;
- (10) Regulating improvements by riparian landowners of the beds, banks and shores of the lakes, streams, and marshes by permit or otherwise in order to preserve the same for beneficial use.

v.

That in general the contemplated improvements would include the following: to provide an outlet to said lakes so as to be able to control and alleviate flooding and damage caused thereby during unusually high water; to provide additional inlets into said lakes so as to be able to control and alleviate damage caused by unusually low water; to provide means to control pollution of said lakes; to provide means to control growth of algae in said lakes; to provide methods of control over the dam separating Spring Lake and Prior Lake; to provide methods of draining flooded farm areas by construction and regulation of drainage ditches; to promote and improve the recreational use of said lakes, including but not limited to the construction and maintenance of fish rearing ponds; the regulation and control of cess pools and waste disposal; the improvement

and proper marking of channels; to obtain adequate records of pertinent data by employees of said watershed district and the preserving of such data in the district office; the regulation of construction of any buildings along the beds, banks or shores of the lakes, streams and marshes, by permit or otherwise.

#### VI.

That the territory to be included in the Prior Lake - Spring Lake
Watershed District lies wholly within Scott County, as shown on said
map, Exhibit "A"; that all of said area as indicated on said map, is
necessary to be included in said watershed district as all of such area
lies within the natural watershed surrounding Prior Lake and Spring Lake.

#### VII.

That the establishment of this watershed district would be condusive to public health and public welfare because it would provide an organization and a method to control waters in an orderly manner and to reduce losses due to unusually high water or unusually low water; that it would provide a method to reduce pollution of waterways and thus aid public health; that it would provide a method to preserve and promote the recreational use of said lakes.

#### VIII.

That your petitioners propose that there be five managers of the Prior Lake - Spring Lake Watershed District;
