How to Use the Hydromet Cloud Website

(<https://www.hydrometcloud.com/Plslwd/>):

Most recent water level data will be displayed on the dashboard. To view past water levels, follow these steps:

- 1) Click on “Data Reports” in the upper right-hand corner of page.
- 2) Click the plus icon near “PLSLWD” to expand the dropdown menu and display the different lakes with water level data.
- 3) Click in the boxes to select the lake(s) and parameter(s) interested in.
 - a. For Prior Lake, WL2 is the sensor for lake level
- 4) Time ranges may be selected at the bottom of the page.
 - a. Data before 2020 for lakes other than Prior Lake will need to be pulled internally – find contact information below.
- 5) Select “Plot” to view a graph of the data
 - a. Hovering cursor over the graph will show the date and water level
- 6) Select “Excel” to download the data as an .xls file
 - a. Data is recorded every 15 minutes; there are tools in Excel to calculate daily averages to better visualize water levels over long periods of time.

Sudden drops or rises in water level from December – March is likely from removing or installing sensors.
